

Donut Delight Necklace and Bracelet



Kit includes:

Chain of choice – 75 cm
8mm open jump rings (50/pkt)
6mm closed jump rings (50/pkt)
Lobster clasp – small x1
Donut strand of your choice

Necklace

1. Cut chain (we've used Antique Brass in this example) into the following lengths:
1 x 10cm; 1 x 35cm and 2 x 15cm
2. Making donut sections – open a Jump Ring (JR) and slip on a donut. Close JR. Open another 8mm JR and slip onto donut with three 6mm closed jump rings (CJR). Close the JR.
3. Open an 8mm JR and slip it through the three 6mm CJRs; add a donut and close JR.
4. Repeat steps 2 and 3 to make a section. Repeat this technique to create two more sections; the donut sections should use donuts in numbers of 3 and two 4s.
5. Simply attach your donut sections to the cut lengths of chain to make the necklace. One part of the necklace has the two equal lengths of chain incorporated to add diversity.



Donut Sections:

Necklace:

Section 1 3 donuts
6 x 8mm OJR
6 x 6mm CJR

Section 2 4 donuts
8 x 8mm OJR
9 x 6mm CJR

Section 3 4 donuts
8 x 8mm OJR
9 x 6mm CJR

Bracelet: 10 donuts
20 x 8mm OJR
25 x 6mm CJR

Bracelet

Follow the technique outlined above for making donut sections, but add a lobster clasp at one end and add a single CJR on the other end to complete bracelet. This will make an approx 19cm bracelet. Add/take away links as needed.

Opening/Closing JRs: Grip the jumpring each side of the opening using pliers and twist apart. Don't pull apart as this will distort and weaken the jumpring. When closing, push the rings slightly past where they join and let the natural spring of the metal perfectly align the sides. You should be able to feel the ends slide against each other and may feel/hear a 'click' when they are aligned.
