

Heart-Star bracelet

A feast of pinks and reds! This bracelet is so pretty with its combination of hearts, stripes & stars. This bracelet final length is 20cm (8") to fit a wrist size 16.5cm (6 ½"). Adjust for your size.



1. Lay out your jumpings and components in the sequence you'll be making the bracelet
2. With the first 12mm jumping, add the lobster clasp. Close the jumping. Open a 14mm jumping, add a DC slice (colour 1), then the 12mm jumping with the lobster clasp attached, followed by a ceramic heart. Close the jumping.
3. Open another 12mm jumping, add it to the 14mm jumping section, and then slip on 3 stars, in the combination: Colour 1, colour 2, colour 1. In the next 12mm jumping, change the star combination to colour 2, colour 1, colour 2. Close the jumping.
4. Open a 14mm jumping, add another DC slice (colour 2), followed by the 12mm jumping section, then the ceramic heart. Close the jumping.
5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 and remember with each alternate 12mm jumping, the star colour combination changes from Colour 1, colour 2, colour 1 to Colour 2, colour 1, colour 2 and with each 14mm jumping, the DC slice colour changes from colour 1 to colour 2
6. On the final 12mm jumping, add a 10mm closed jumping. That completes the bracelet.

Components:

Greek Beads:

8 x ceramic hearts
12 x stars colour 1
12 x stars colour 2

Findings:

1 x 15mm lobster clasp
1 x 10mm closed jumping
9 x 12mm open jumpings
8 x 14mm open jumpings

David Christensen glass slices beads:

4 x slices – colour 1
4 x slices – colour 2

In this version, we've used:

Greek Beads:

8 x ceramic powder pink hearts
12 x fuschia stars
12 x red stars

Findings:

1 x 15mm lobster clasp
1 x 10mm closed jumping
9 x 12mm open jumpings
8 x 14mm open jumpings

David Christensen glass slices beads:

4 x red & white stripe hearts
4 x white squares
