

Impyra Necklace

There are so many colours of the Greek bead matte round washers to choose from. You'll find that certain combinations may evoke a mood, a favoured colour range and even the seasons. The necklace shown above is very bright & zesty. Have fun experimenting!



1. Take 17 inches (c. 43cm) of Greek leather round cord and slip an end crimp onto it. Using chain-nose pliers, squeeze the middle section of the end crimp quite hard so it grips the Greek leather.

2. Add a 3mm crimp. Now you're ready to make a colour combination of round washers – see above for an example. We've used the silver metallic washers to top and tail the colour section. The colour section contains 26 beads.

3. Add a curved tube, following by a silver washer, 2 x washers of colour 1 and another silver washer. Add a Greek bead top and then repeat the beads and colour sequence in reverse to complete the other half of the necklace.

4. Don't forget to add another 3mm crimp bead. Add the end crimp, squeezing in the middle section as before.

5. To centre and fix the necklace so the components don't move about, hold the end crimps together so each leather strand is side-by-side. Walk your thumb & forefinger down the leather strands, pushing the components towards the centre. Once centred on the necklace, simply squeeze both of the 3mm crimps onto the leather.

Components:

Greek Beads:

- 26 x washers colour 1
- 12 x washers colour 2
- 4 x washers colour 3
- 18 x metallic 8mm round washers
- 2 x curved metallic tubes
- 1 x Top

Other:

- 2 x 3mm crimps
- 1 x pair of end crimps (2mm)

In this version, we've used:

Greek Beads:

- 26 x washers colour 1 – lime
- 12 x washers colour 2 – pear
- 4 x washers colour 3 – matte silver
- 18 x metallic 8mm round washers - silver
- 2 x curved metallic tubes - silver
- 1 x Top – White Opal

Other:

- 2 x 3mm crimps – silver plated
- 1 x pair of end crimps (2mm) – silver plated
- 17 inches of Greek leather (2mm) - black
