

Two tone DC Necklace



1. Cut chain (we've used Gun Metal in this example) into the following lengths:
1 x 29cm; 10 x 2.5cm
2. Take the headpins/eyepins, Swarovski crystals and David Christensen round chubs to make 12 bead sections: If you've got headpins, cut the head off, then using your round nose pliers, hold the end of the wire and roll the wire over to form a semi-circle. Let go of the wire and move the pliers around the loop a little, then continue to roll the wire until you have made a circular loop, centred above the vertical line of the headpin. If you have eyepins, the first loop is already formed.
3. Add a Swarovski, DC bead & Swarovski. Then form another circular loop using the technique in step 2. Make all 12 DC bead sections.
4. Add a colour DC bead section to each side of the 29cm chain, opening the circular loop and closing it again. This is the start of the necklace. Add a 10cm chain length to each bead section on the necklace. Then add a different colour DC bead section, followed by a chain length. Add three DC bead sections, followed by another chain length, DC bead section and chain length.
5. Open the 8mm jumpring and slip both chain length ends into the jumpring, along with the 2 remaining chain lengths.
6. Add the 10mm jumprings to the chain length and slip on DC slices to finish off. Close the jumprings.

Components:

6 x David Christensen round chubs colour 1
6 x David Christensen round chubs colour 2
2 x David Christensen small slices for ends
12 x 4mm Swarovski beads
12 x headpins or eyepins
1 x 8mm open jumpring
2 x 10- 12mm open jumprings
1 x 29cm chain length
10 x 2.5cm chain lengths

In this version, we've used:
6 x DC turquoise round chubs
6 x DC magenta round chubs
2 x DC turquoise slices
12 x 4mm vitrail Swarovski beads
Gunmetal as the base metal
Chain is rollo chain (GM01 – chain page)
1 x 29cm chain length is 112 links
2.5cm chain length is 10 links
