

## Worry Fish bubble Necklace



1. Lay out the beads in the sequence you will string them. Each end of the bead or fish segment has a 4mm ball and a crimp on it – the 4mm ball finishes the segment and the crimps hold the segment in place on the beading chain.
2. Take an end crimp and slide it onto the beading chain. Crimp the end crimp in the middle section and this will hold the beading chain.
3. String a crimp, 4mm ball, fish tail, 4mm ball and crimp.
4. String another crimp, 4mm ball, fish segment, 4mm ball and crimp. Continue in this fashion until after the fourth fish segment.
5. Add a crimp, 4mm ball, then a teardrop in one colour and another teardrop, followed by a 4mm ball and a crimp.
6. Repeat step 4. Then repeat step 5
7. Repeat step 4 using the final fish segment – the head. Then repeat step 5 twice.
8. Add a crimp, 4mm ball, one teardrop, 4mm ball & crimp. Repeat this step twice more, using a different colour teardrop.
9. Add the final end crimp onto the beading chain and squeeze the middle section using snipe nose pliers.
10. Now arrange the beads and fish segments along the fish necklace. The fish head should be positioned so that it is on the up side of one side of the necklace rather than placed in the middle point of the necklace. This gives the necklace interest as if the fish is dipping up to follow the teardrop bubbles back up to the surface. Crimp the bead segments in place using snipe nose pliers on each of the crimps.

### Components:

6 x fish segments  
 18 to 20" beading chain  
 2 x end crimps  
 28 round 4mm balls  
 28 crimps  
 5 x teardrop colour 1  
 7 x teardrop colour 2

### In this version, we've used:

6 x fish segments  
 18" gunmetal beading chain  
 2 x gunmetal end crimps  
 28 gunmetal round 4mm balls  
 28 gunmetal crimps  
 5 x teardrop: Dark Sky Blue  
 7 x teardrop: Carolina Blue
