



# Purple Beech Designs

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAKING A PURPLE BEECH DESIGNS LONG RUFFLE NECKLACE



1. Attach the toggle clasp to each end of the chain using the 6mm open jumpings ([see link\\*](#)).
2. Make your “dangles”. Using the headpins provided, make up 22 swarovski dangles. Also make up 15 donut dangles by placing a seamless ball, boro bead and seamless ball on the headpin ([see link\\*](#))
3. Make up 6 linked boro beads. Using wirecutters, snip off the top of the headpin and make a loop to form an eyepin. Put a seamless ball, boro bead and seamless ball on the eyepin and finish the loop.
4. Going back to your chain, measure  $\approx 14$  cm and begin attaching the first cluster of 6 Swarovski dangles by using your 4 mm open jumpings. Attach a dangle to each link in the chain. Repeat this process so that both sides of the chain are equal.
5. Using wirecutters, cut the chain  $\approx 4$  cm from the end of the cluster and attach 3 of the boro links. Re-attach the round cable chain and add 2 boro dangles on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> links.
6. Your next cluster of crystals starts  $\approx 3$  cm after this and includes 2 boro dangles. This is mirrored on both sides of the chain.
7. Lastly, work from the middle of your chain and add your remaining boro dangles on every other link to complete your necklace.
