

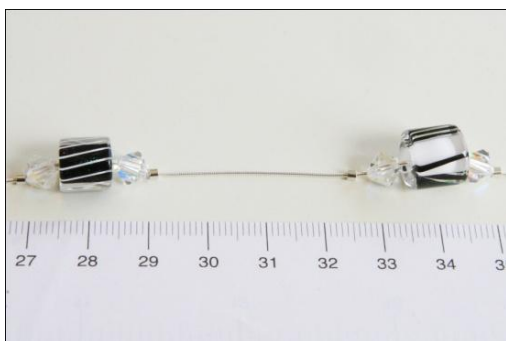


# Purple Beech Designs

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAKING A PURPLE BEECH DESIGNS SNAKE CHAIN NECKLACE WITH FURNACE GLASS BEADS



1. Cut the sterling silver snake chain provided to the desired length using a good pair of cutting pliers (NOT scissors). Cut the chain on a diagonal as it is easier to insert into end cap.
2. Put the chain into the hole at the base of the end cap making sure that the chain goes all the way to the end, but does not stick out at the top. Gently, but firmly, pinch the indentation in the middle of the cap using needle nose pliers to secure the chain.
3. Slip a crimp bead, Swarovski, glass bead, Swarovski and crimp bead onto your chain. Repeat this step until all your components are on the chain. **DOUBLE CHECK** to make sure everything is in order before you attach the last end cap!
4. Attach the end cap and crimp in the middle.
5. Using either a bead board or a ruler, measure out equal distances and position your pattern. For a 50 cm necklace this is approx. every 6 cm. Use the needle nose pliers to secure the crimp beads for your design. It's usually best to start with crimping the middle section and then working on either side of your piece to finish the pattern. Attach the lobster claw using needle nose pliers to open and close the jump ring over the end cap.
